The Pentecost Offering unites us in a church-



Each year on Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the church. The Holy Spirit remains with us still, connecting us with the church of the past, continuing to inspire the church of today, and pointing us to the church of the future.

Since the Pentecost Offering started in 1998, Presbyterian have raised nearly \$18 million for ministries that benefit younger members of God's family. We believe we are called to do even more — to support and care for young people as they build a strong foundation of faith.

Sunday School Updates


The Sunday School year will wrap up on May 18, 2025. We will celebrate and recognize our teachers to thank them for their year of service to the kids and adults of Central.
